PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REGULATION AND PERMIT CHANGES FOR THE COMMERCIAL HARVEST OF SNAPPING TURTLES

- Minimum curve-line carapace length shall be 13”
- Only Virginia residents shall be eligible to commercially harvest or assist in the harvesting of snapping turtles
- Only 25 permits per year shall be issued
- No longer will auto renewal be allowed, but permits shall be issued on a “first come, first serve” basis
- Permits applications will not be accepted earlier than March 1st. If received before March 1st, applications will be discarded
- Only 20 traps shall be operated per harvester/permit
- Set poles will no longer be permitted as a method to commercially harvest snapping turtles
- Copies of sales receipts should accompany Annual Reports

Note: There are several changes to the Permit Conditions and it is imperative that all permittees read and understand all of the permit conditions BEFORE exercising the privileges granted by being issued a permit.

PERMIT TO COLLECT SNAPPING TURTLES AND HELLGRAMMITES
FOR SALE
PERMIT CONDITIONS

As provided for in § 29.1-417 of the Code of Virginia and 4 VAC 15-360-30 of the Virginia Administrative Code, this permit will be required by any person collecting snapping turtles and/or hellgrammites from the wild for commercial purposes. This permit will be revoked for violation of any of the following conditions, restrictions or limitations (4 VAC 15-290-130).

A. PERMITTED SPECIES TO BE COLLECTED AND SOLD:

Snapping Turtles (*Chelydra serpentina*)

Hellgrammites

B. RECORD KEEPING:

Permittee will be required to keep a record of collecting activities and submit an annual report to the Department by November 1st. This report must be received before a new permit will be issued.

Not submitting an annual report by November 1 will be considered a permit violation and a citable offense under 4 VAC 15-360-30 and denial of future permit applications.

Annual Report (provided by VDWR) should include:

- Date of each collection
- Location of collection (county & water)
- Number of animals collected
- Number or pounds collected
- Copies of sale receipts

C. EXCEPTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS:

- The Chickahominy River and its tributaries from Walkers Dam to the Rt. 5/Dressler bridge will be permanently closed for the commercial harvest of snapping turtles.
- The following rivers, streams and tributaries will be closed until the onset of the 2025 collection season:
 - o Totusky Creek (in Richmond County)
 - o Mattaponi River (from Walkerton Road bridge to West Point bridge)
 - o Cat Point Creek (in Richmond County)
 - o Warwick River (in the City of Newport News)
 - o College Creek (in James City County)
 - o Pagan River (in Isle of Wight County)
- No species listed as threatened or endangered shall be possessed or sold (4 VAC 15-20-130C., Virginia Administrative Code).
- Only 3'x 6' hoop nets or similarly constructed traps shall be allowed and must be checked every 24 hours.

- Permit number and/or name and address of permittee shall be clearly marked or labeled on all traps.
- All other species of wildlife, including other species of turtle, shall be released unharmed.
- Minimum shell size for snapping turtles shall be 13 inches lengthwise (from front to back) following the curve of the shell.
- Snapping turtles may not be collected for commercial purposes from October 1 through May 31.
- Snapping turtles may not be taken from the banks or waters of designated stocked trout waters.
- It shall be unlawful to use seines, nets or traps in Lick Creek in Smyth and Bland Counties, in Bear Creek and Hungry Mother Creek above Hungry Mother Lake in Smyth County, and Laurel Creek in Tazewell and Bland Counties. This shall not be construed to prohibit the use of hand-landing nets for the landing of fish legally hooked (4 VAC 15-340-60).
- Permittee must carry a copy of this permit during trapping activities.

D. TERM OF PERMIT:

Permits are issued for a one-year period beginning November 1st and expiring October 31st.

E. PERMIT HOLDER TO BE PRESENT WHEN COLLECTING; PERSONS ASSISTING:

The holder of a permit to collect must be present at all times when collecting. Persons assisting in the operation need not obtain permits, but must also be residents of Virginia.

F. PERMIT RENEWAL PROCEDURES:

4 VAC 15-30-7 of the Virginia Administrative Code states that provided that the issuance of a permit renewal has been delayed past the expiration date of the permittee's previous permit at no fault of the applicant, the permittee may continue the specific activities authorized by the expired permit until the Department has acted on such person's application for renewal. To qualify for this allowance, applicants must submit a completed renewal application to the Department at least 30 days prior to the expiration date of the permit. The Department may deny renewal of a permit to any applicant who fails to meet the issuance criteria set forth by the Department. Permit applications for the harvest of snapping turtles will not be accepted before March 1st. If received before March 1st, applications will be discarded.

G. FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAWS:


This permit does not absolve the permittee of any responsibilities or conditions of any other Federal, State, or Local laws and regulations, including those that apply to Threatened/Endangered (T&E) Species.

H. COMPLIANCE/VIOLATION/REVOCAION:

1. 4 VAC 15-290-130 of the Virginia Administrative Act requires that a permit holder shall comply with all terms and conditions of any permit issued by the Department of Wildlife Resources pursuant to Title 29.1 of the Code of Virginia and the regulations of the board pertaining to hunting, fishing, trapping, attempting to take, possession, sale, offering for sale, transporting or causing to

be transported, importing or exporting, propagating, exhibiting, and rehabilitating of any wild bird, wild animal or fish. The penalty for violation of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor unless another penalty is specified. Further any violation of state or federal wildlife laws related to the permitted activities by the permittee, his/her agents or employees, or guests will constitute a violation of the conditions of the permit.

2. As provided by 4 VAC 15-30-5 of the Virginia Administrative Code, failure to comply with the provisions of a permit may result in the revocation or suspension of the permit for a period up to but not to exceed five (5) years. Any person whose permit is revoked, or suspended may appeal that decision in writing, to the Executive Director, Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources, P. O. Box 3337, Henrico, VA 23228.
