






Welcome to Bear Creek Lake State Park. Enjoy spacious surroundings amidst a tranquil setting of hardwood forest and a picturesque man-made lake. To make your visit safer and more pleasant, please observe the following regulations:


 Hiking trails are for pedestrians only. Bicycles and horses are permitted on the Cumberland Multi-Use Trail. No motorized vehicles are allowed on state park trails.


 Help preserve your park. Please don't cut or mar any plants or trees. Collecting animal or plant life is allowed by permit only for scientific purposes.

 Pets are permitted in all state parks but must be kept in an enclosed area or on a leash no longer than six feet.


 Swimming and wading are allowed only in the designated area during operating hours. Gasoline motors are prohibited. Electric trolling motors are welcome.

 Please help us keep the park clean by placing litter in the proper receptacles.

 The public use or display of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.

 Skateboards, roller blades and scooters are prohibited.

 Riding bicycles after sunset is prohibited.

 Park is open for day use from 8 a.m. to dusk daily.
