






Welcome to Holliday Lake State Park. Located in the 20,000 acre Appomattox Buckingham State Forest, the park is an oasis of outdoor recreation opportunity. Swimming, boating and fishing are popular on this man-made lake. The park offers miles of lakefront hiking trails and 30 electric and water campsites. The following regulations have been established to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for protection of this valuable resource:

-  The public use or display of alcoholic beverages is prohibited.
-  Help preserve your park. Please don't cut or mar any plants or trees. Collecting animal or plant life is allowed only for scientific purposes by permit from the Richmond headquarters.
-  Pets are permitted in all state parks, but they must be kept on a leash not to exceed six feet at all times or in an enclosed area.
-  Swimming and wading are allowed only in the designated area during operating hours. Boats with electric trolling motors are welcome.
-  Please help us keep the park clean by placing litter in the proper receptacles.
