January 22 - 23, 2025	<p>Wildlife and Boat Committee & DWR Board Meeting</p> <p>Wildlife staffs will review significant feedback received during the public scoping period and seek Board input on potential regulation amendment issues.</p>

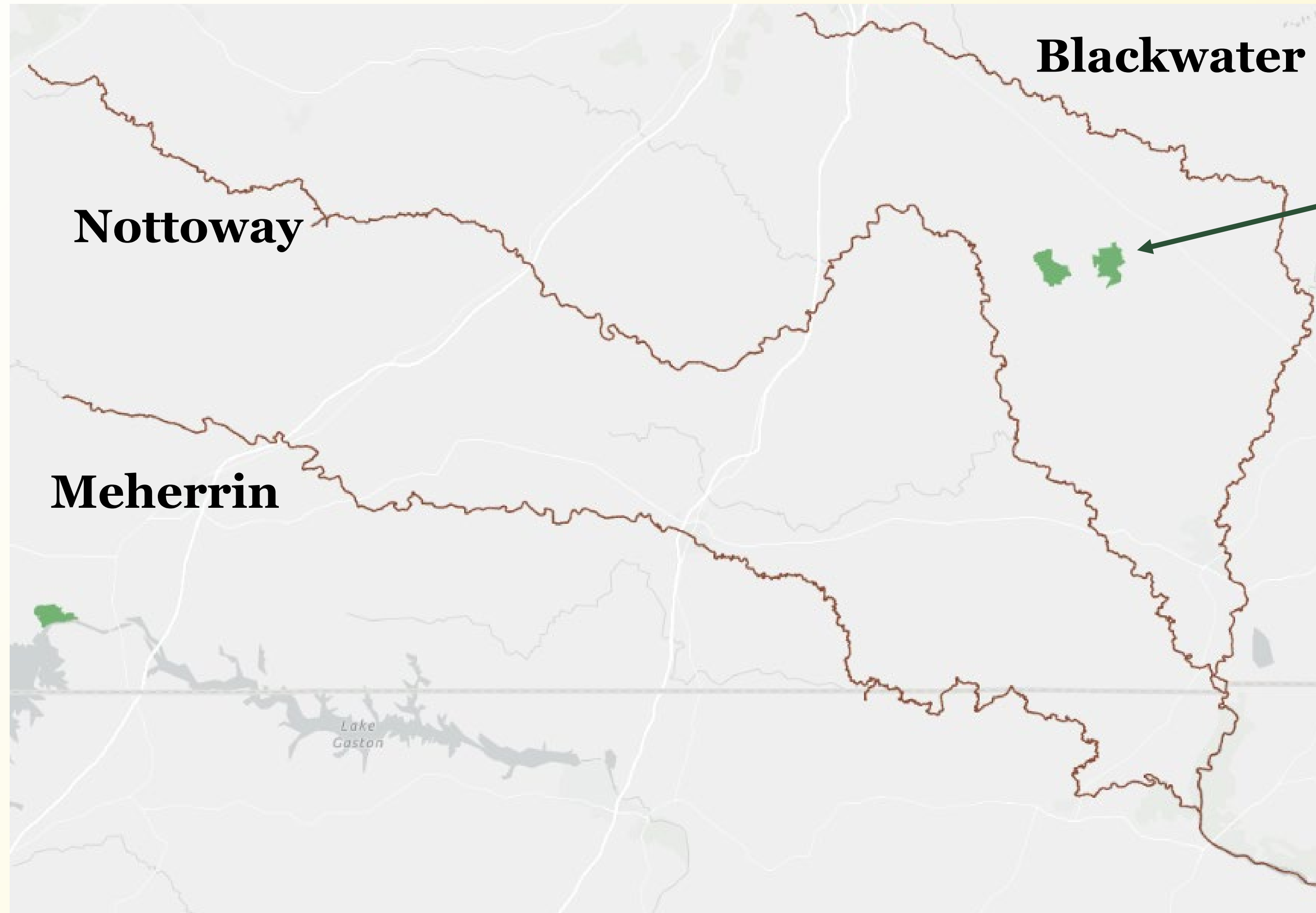

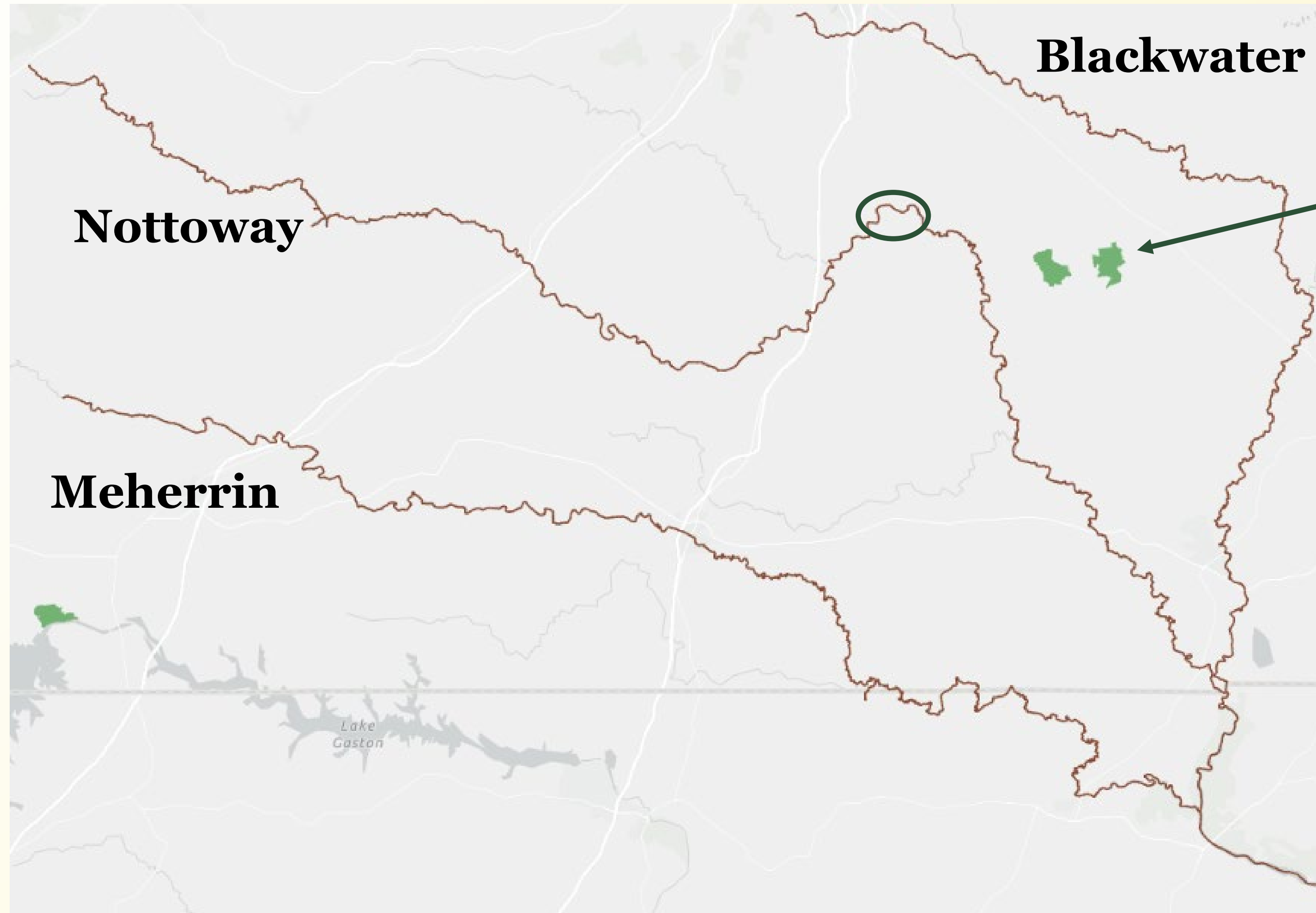

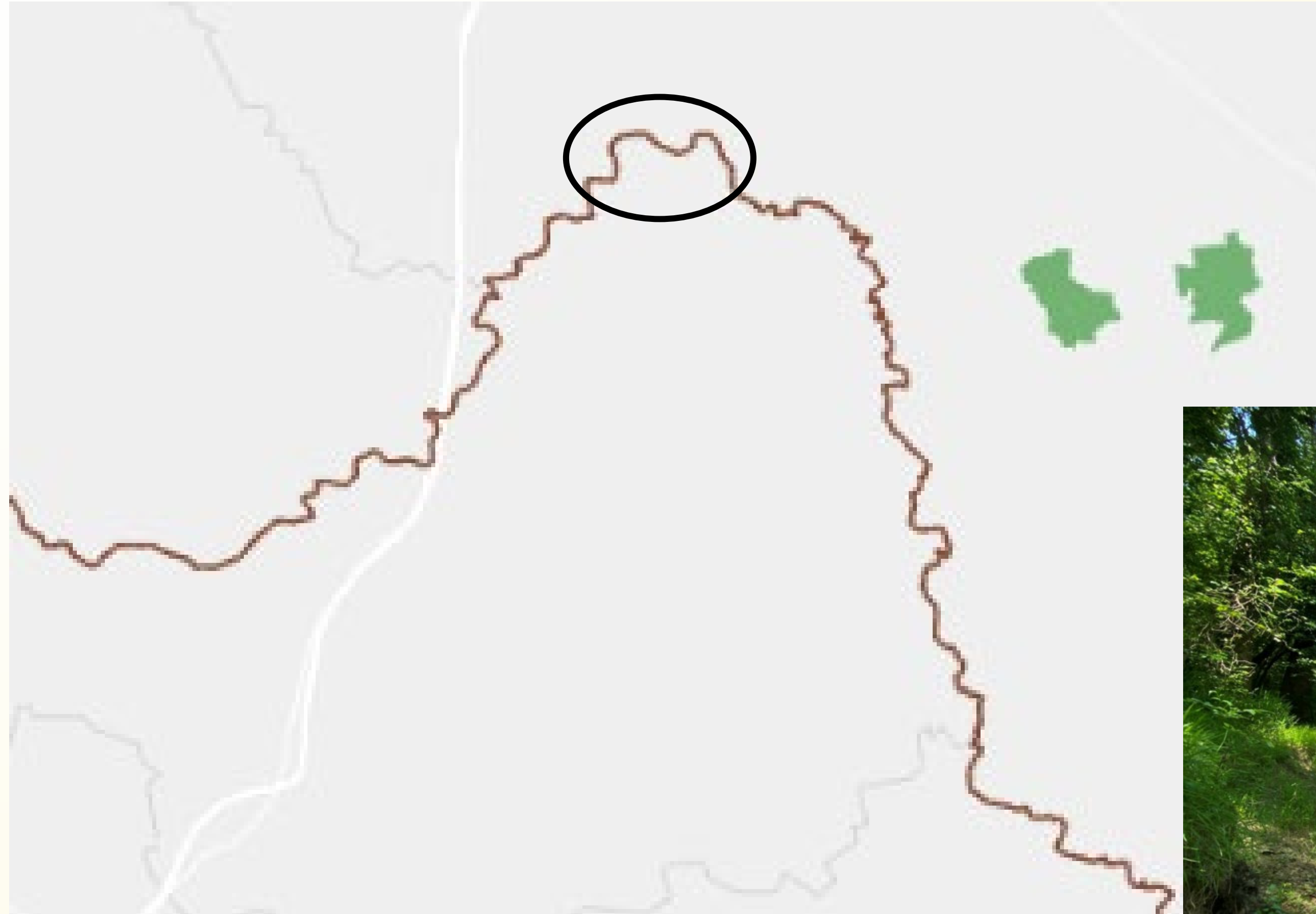
