Chronic Wasting Disease Testing in Disease Management Area 2

Hunters who are successful on any day of the deer hunting season in DMA2 counties (Arlington, Culpeper, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, Madison, Orange, Page, Prince William, or Rappahannock) are encouraged to voluntarily get their deer tested for chronic wasting disease (CWD) by bringing it to a voluntary CWD fridge site.

Instructions for Voluntary Submissions of Deer Heads for CWD Testing

- 1. Bring the head and 3-4 inches of neck to a voluntary CWD fridge site. Heads with the antlers and/or skull plate removed can still be tested.
- 2. Heads should be as fresh as possible (i.e., submitted a few days after death and kept cold prior to submission).
- 3. If you plan to mount the head, submit the head and 3-4 inches of neck *after* caping is complete.
- 4. Fill out the data card per instructions posted at the fridge site.

Disease Management Area 2 Voluntary CWD Fridge Sites

CULPEPER COUNTY

- 1. **Brandy Station Fire Department** 19601 Church Rd, Brandy Station, VA 22714 The self-service facility is located next to the building directly across the street from the fire station.
- Merrimac Sports Shop & Grocery 10096 James Monroe Hwy, Culpeper, VA 22701

The self-service facility is located on the front side of the building to the left of the front door.

FAIRFAX COUNTY

- Mason Neck State Park 7301 High Point Rd, Lorton, VA 22079 The self-service facility is located behind the main kiosk at the park entrance. Notify park employees that you are dropping off a deer for CWD testing, and they will let you through free of charge.
- 4. Veterans of Foreign Wars 1051 Spring Hill Rd, McLean, VA 22102 The self-service facility is located under the overhang on the back left side of the building.

FAUQUIER COUNTY

- 5. **Glascock Grocery & Middle East** 8294 East Main St, Marshall, VA 20115 The self-service facility is located on the left side of the building next to the parking lot.
- Nick's Market & Deli 11127 Marsh Rd, Bealeton, VA 22712 The self-service facility is located on the left side of the building next to the parking lot.

LOUDOUN COUNTY

- Philomont General Store 36550 Philomont Rd, Purcellville, VA 20132 The self-service facility is located on the back of the building near the parking lot.
- Willowsford Conservancy 23516 Fleetwood Rd, Aldie, VA 20105 The self-service facility is located to the left of the front gate when approaching the building.

ORANGE COUNTY

 The Market at Locust Grove – 32301 Constitution Hwy, Locust Grove, VA 22508

The self-service facility is located on the back left corner of the building near the tables and diesel fueling station.

PAGE COUNTY

10. **Stanley Volunteer Fire Department** – 190 East Main Street, Stanley, VA 22851

The self-service facility is located next to the garage door of the first building on the right. Please do not block the garage with your vehicle, as first responders need access to quickly respond to emergency calls.

PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY

- Cabela's Gainesville 5291 Wellington Branch Dr, Gainesville, VA 20155 The self-service facility is located on the front left of the building near the boat display.
- 12. Nokesville Volunteer Fire Department 12826 Marsteller Dr, Nokesville, VA 20181

The self-service facility is located on the front left of the building next to the red double doors.

RAPPAHANNOCK COUNTY

13. Washington Volunteer Fire Department – 10 Firehouse Lane, Washington, VA 22747

The self-service facility is located in front of the second building on your right. Drive straight past the first parking area towards the garage, and the fridge will be on the left side of the back building. Please do not block the garage with your vehicle, as first responders need access to quickly respond to emergency calls.

Disease Management Area 2 Mandatory Day CWD Stations

No counties within Disease Management Area 2 will have any Mandatory Day CWD stations. There will be **no mandatory CWD testing** in Arlington, Culpeper, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun, Madison, Orange, Page, Prince William, or Rappahannock counties in the 2024 hunting season.
