



Voluntary CWD Testing in Disease Management Area 3

Hunters who are successful on any day of the deer hunting season in Carroll, Floyd, Montgomery, and Pulaski counties are encouraged to voluntarily get their deer tested for chronic wasting disease (CWD) by bringing it to a voluntary CWD testing collection site.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HUNTERS VOLUNTARILY SUBMITTING DEER HEADS FOR CWD TESTING

1. Submit at least 3 inches of the neck with the head (head and neck are required for sampling).
2. If you plan to mount the head, do not submit it, or submit the caped out head.
3. If you do not intend to mount your head, but would like to remove the antlers and skull plate, feel free to do so before submitting the head. We can still obtain a sample.
4. Head must be as fresh as possible: a few days after death, and kept *cold*.
5. Please fill out the data card per instructions posted at the self-service location.
