DWR is conducting enhanced chronic wasting disease (CWD) surveillance during the 2021 - 22 deer hunting season in Floyd, Montgomery, and Pulaski counties. Hunters who are successful on any day of the season are encouraged to get their deer tested for CWD by bringing it to one of our voluntary CWD deer head drop sites.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR HUNTERS VOLUNTARILY SUBMITTING DEER HEADS FOR CWD TESTING**

1. Submit at least 3 inches of the neck with the head (head and neck are required for sampling).
2. If you plan to mount the head, do not submit it, or submit after caping.
3. If you do not intend to mount your head, but would like to remove the antlers and skull plate, feel free to do so before submitting the head. We can still obtain a sample.
4. Head must be as fresh as possible, therefore should be submitted within a few days after death and kept *cold* prior to submission.
5. Please fill out the data card per instructions posted at the self-service location.
