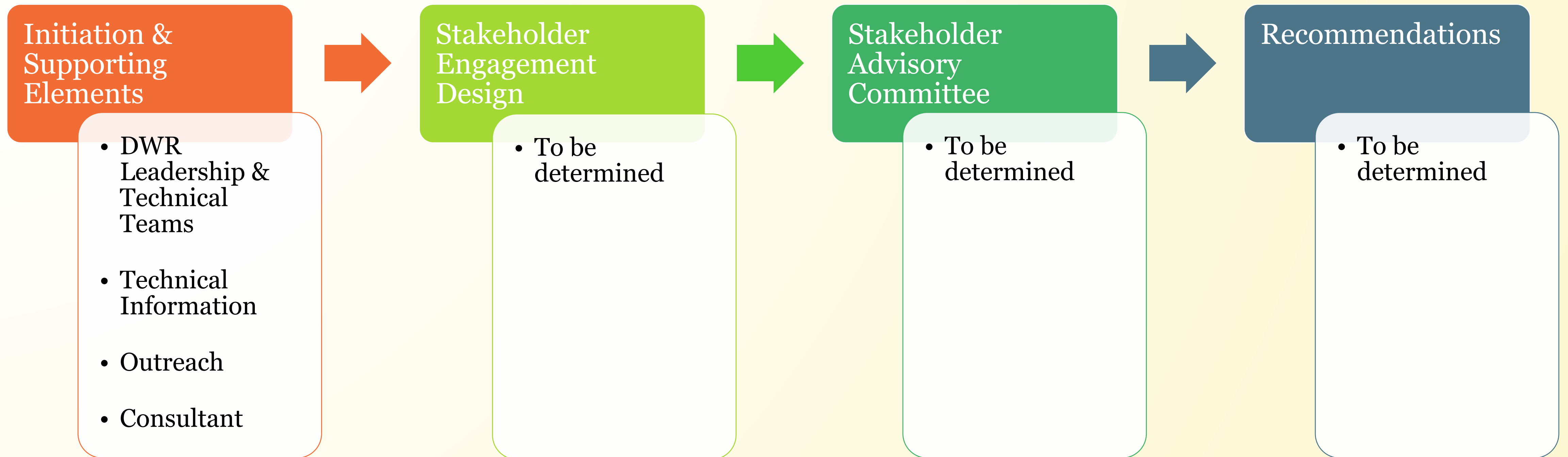
# Brief Context

- The Problem: Ongoing issues between landowners and hound-hunters concerning the presence of hunting dogs on private lands
  - Recent issues have largely been associated with deer and bear
- 19 January 2023: The DWR Board authorized the Director to:

*“... appoint an **ad hoc advisory committee** to consider the rights of landowners and hunters and advise the Board on possible changes to regulations that might address some of the current issues.”*
