Ethical Hunting With Dogs

Dog Retrieval

Hunters using hounds, when the chase begins on other lands, may follow their dogs onto private lands to retrieve their dogs, but:

- Hunters not pursuing foxes or raccoons may not carry firearms, bow, or arrows
- May not use a vehicles to retrieve dogs without the permission of the landowner
- Should minimize the number of hunters involved in the retrieval
- Must identify themselves when requested by the landowner

Key Concepts for Other Hunters

- Be respectful of other hunter's dogs
- Never shoot when a hunting dog is close: Know your target and beyond
- Removing a dog's collar is illegal
- Be respectful of other hunter's hunts
