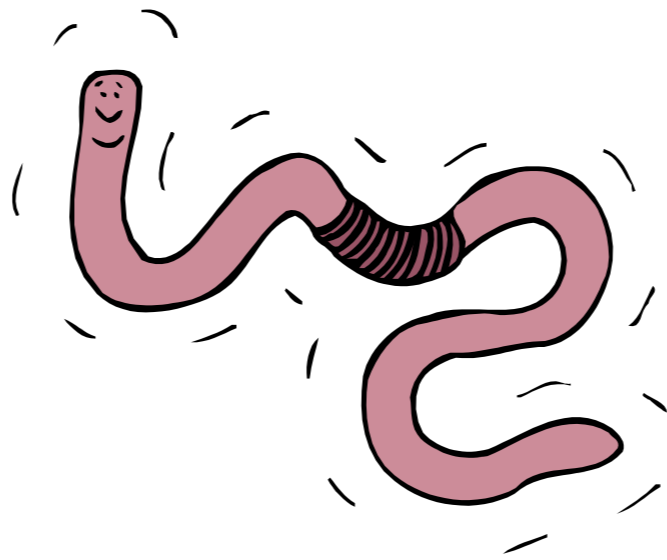
# Worm Song

Up the soil, up the soil.

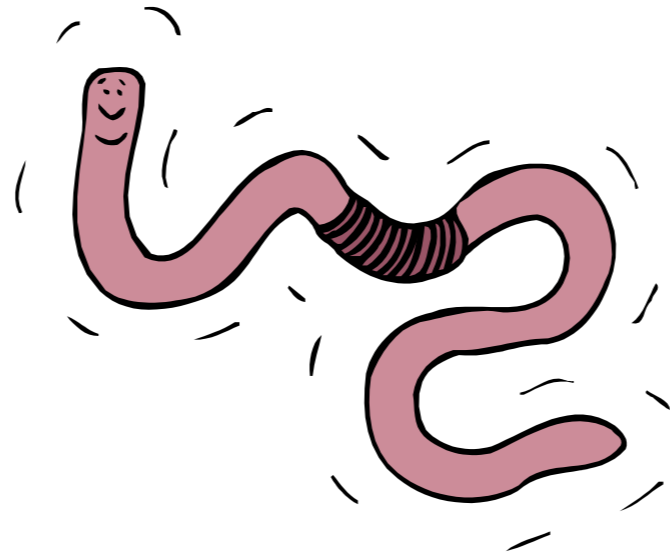
The worms are mixing up the soil,

(to the tune of "Jingle Bells")

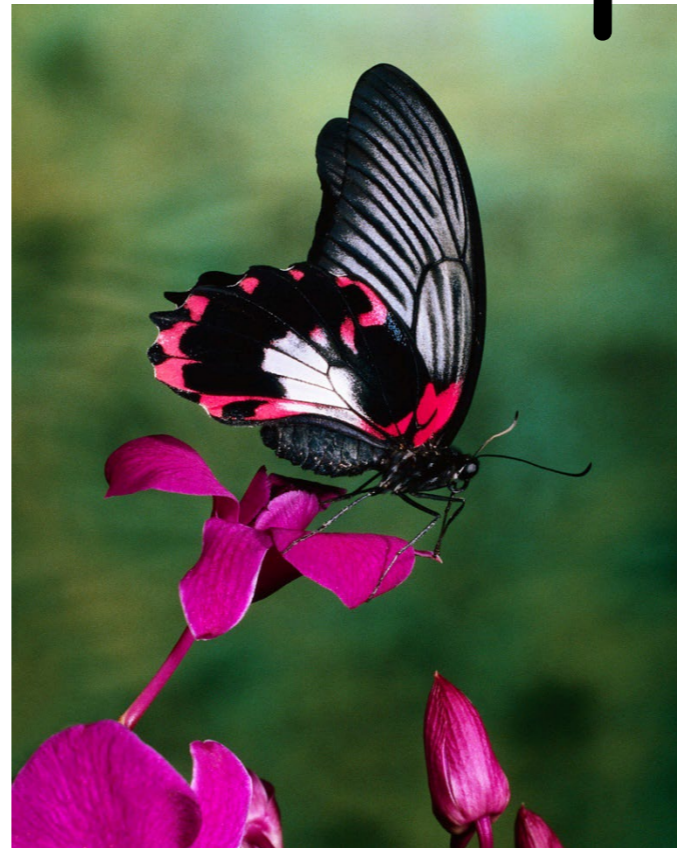
Camouflage, camouflage

All different types

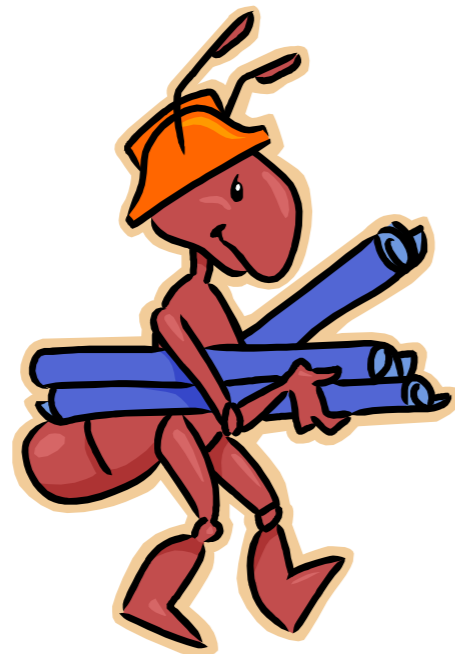
Camouflage, camouflage

# Butterfly Song

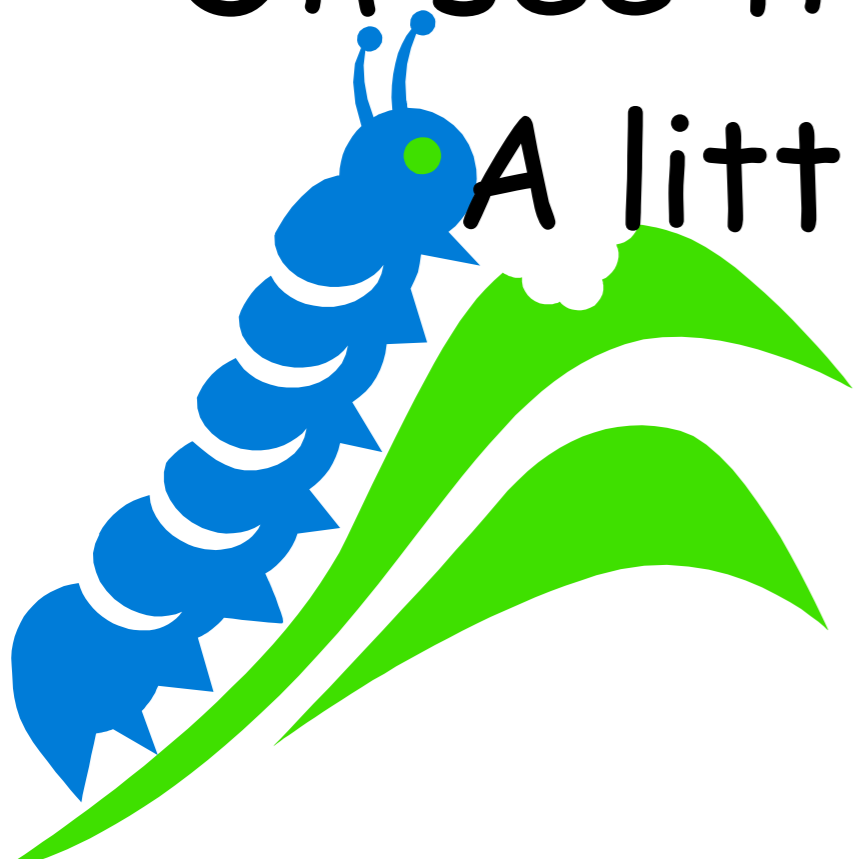
(tune: Up on the Housetop)

egg.

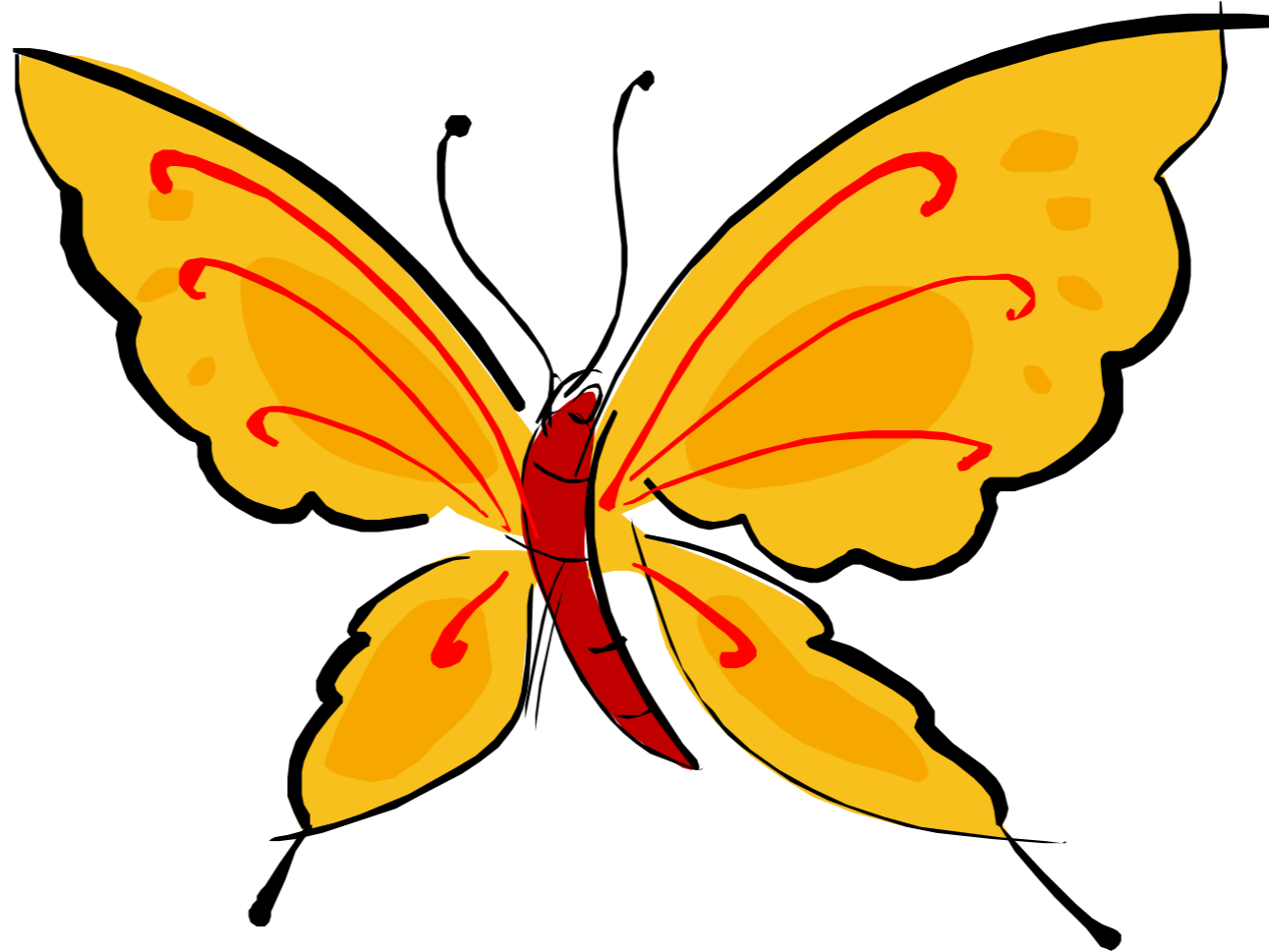
Out comes a caterpillar with many legs.

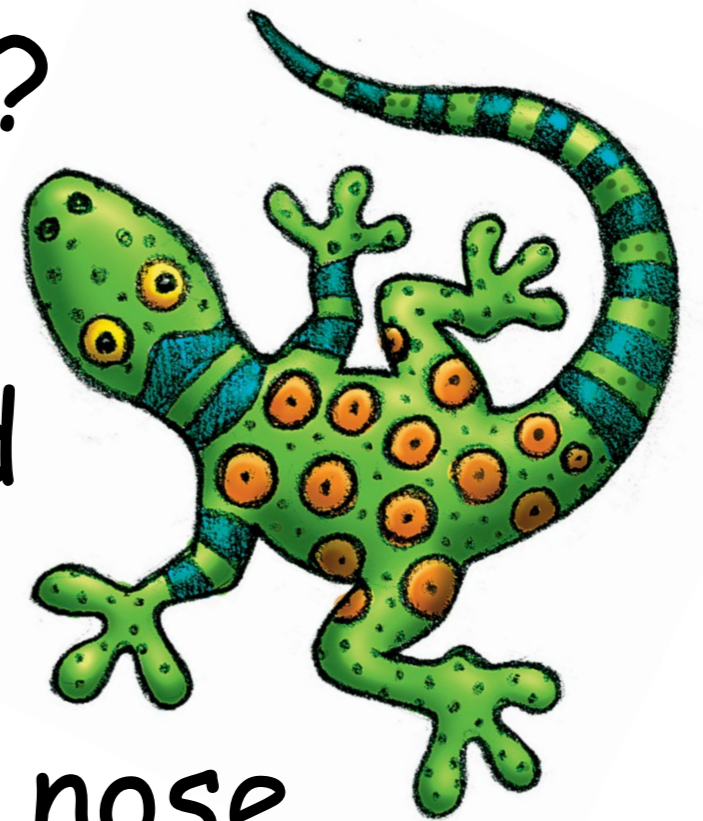
All dressed up in green?

Like using a straw in a cup

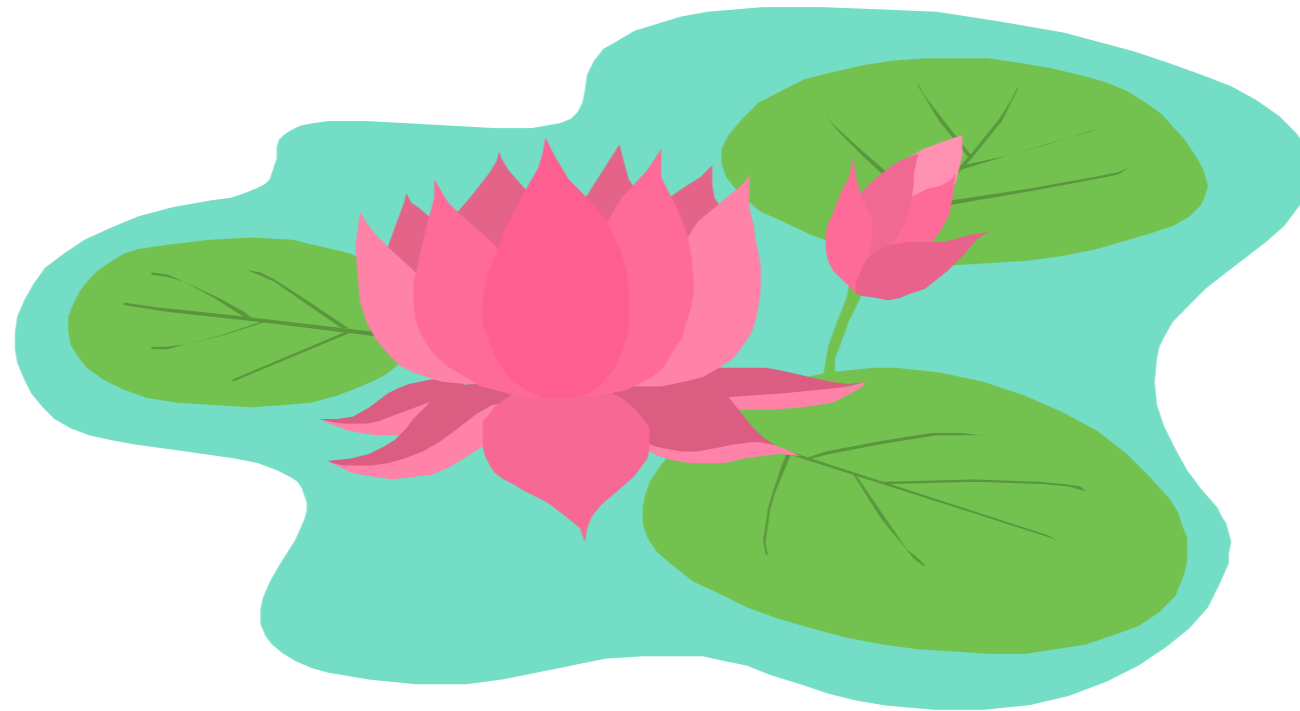


I'm a little squirrel in a tree

As they sat and ate nuts in the big tall tree.





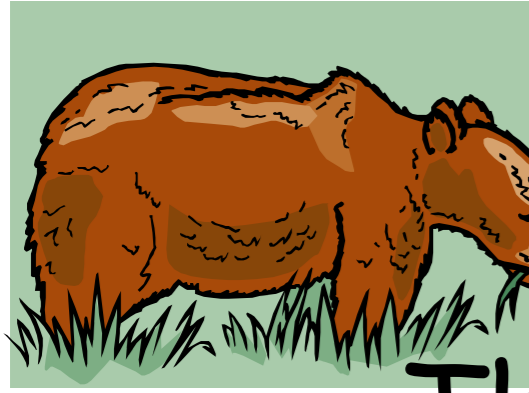

The bears are fattening in the fall,

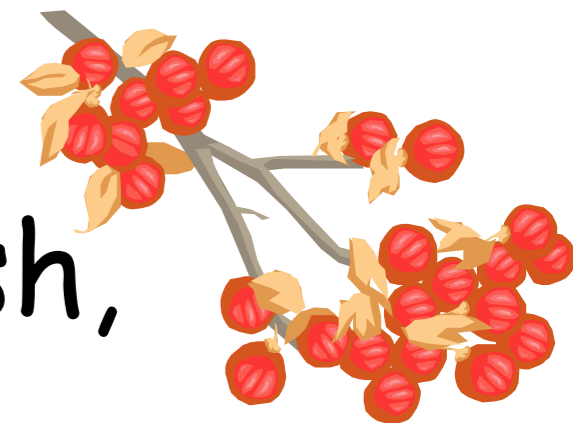
Before their winter sleep.

They're eating berries from the bush,

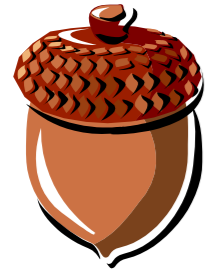

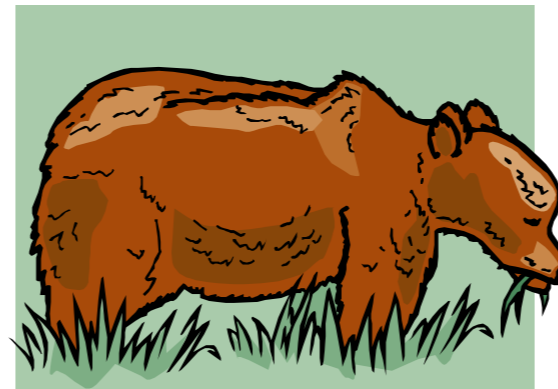

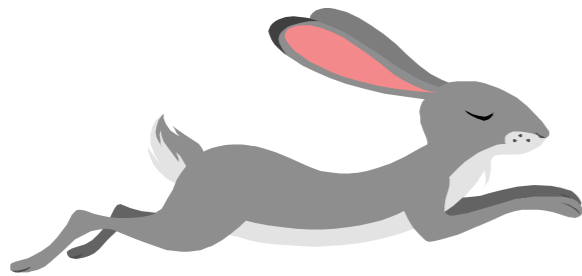
# WHERE'S THE HABITAT?

Prance away, spring away



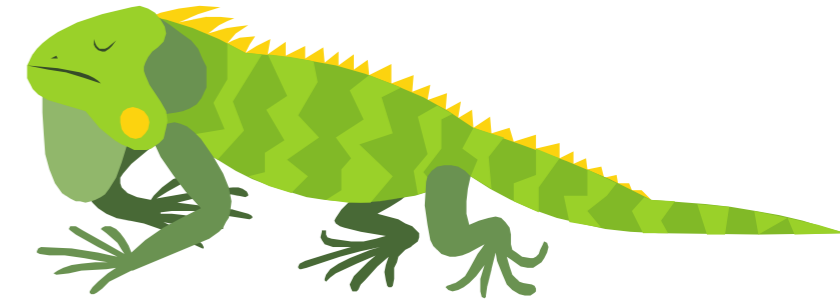
Where's the lizard? Where's the lizard?
