

# Wildlife is Everywhere

**Objectives:**

Students will (1) compare human and wildlife habitat, and (2) generalize that wildlife is present around the world.

**Method:**

Students search their surroundings for evidence of wildlife.

**Procedure:**

- Lay your grid in a spot that you think you will be able to find wildlife.
- Search for evidence that wildlife lives in the area: it may be an actual animal, a chewed leaf, feather or other evidence.
- Record or draw your findings in the grid below.
- Be prepared to share your results with other workshop participants.
