# Licensed Captain, Commercial Fisherman, and Exempted Boaters Card Request

**Instructions:** 

1) This form is for persons who meet one of the exemptions listed below or took a NASBLA approved course in another state. If you have taken a classroom or internet boater safety course in Virginia, please go to this website to purchase your life time boater's card:

### **Exempted**

- a. People who hold a U.S. Coast Guard license to operate a vessel (Master, Captain, or Mate)
- b. People who possess a Registered Commercial Fisherman License issued by the Virginia Marine Resources Commission
- c. People who possess a marine certificate issued by the Canadian government or a Canadian Pleasure Craft Operator's Card.
- d. People who are or have been a surface warfare officer or enlisted surface warfare specialist.
- e. People who are or have qualified as an Officer of the Deck Underway, boat coxswain, boat officer, boat operator, watercraft operator, or Marine Deck Officer in any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States, Unites States Coast Guard, or Merchant Marine.
- 2) Fill out the form attached.
- 3) Include a copy of a valid ID card (if available).
- 4) Include copies of supporting documents for any exemption category selected.
- 5) Sign and date the form. The form must be signed by the requestor or by the person certifying the request on behalf of the requestor.
- 6) Mail the request form and supporting documentation to the address listed below. Do not include payment with the form.

7) Once you submit the request, please allow 30 business days for our online boating safety card system to be updated with the information. We will contact you when your information has been added to our card system. Once updated, you may purchase a boater's card by calling 800-830-2268 or going to https://www.ilostmycard.com. The card costs \$10.00.
